At the Baby Shower, your Council or Assembly can serve cake and punch, while collecting donations of clothing for children and mothers, diapers, formula, toys, gift certificates, cash, etc. The donations can be given to local Pregnancy Care Centers, Pregnancy Crisis Centers, Adoption Services Facilities, The Gabriel Project, Project Rachel or any other program or service in your area which is committed to the sanctity of life and the dignity of every human person.

The Baby Shower Program is intended for participation of every Council and Assembly in Virginia, but your Council or Assembly will choose the local programs and services to receive the donations collected at your Baby Shower.

A list of local programs and services throughout Virginia is being compiled to help you identify potential recipients. This list will be sent to all Grand Knights through their District Deputies in the coming months. But don't let waiting for the list stop you from finding your own recipient. Perhaps there is a mother in your parish, whom you can "adopt" during her pregnancy, supporting her with your prayers and donations.
